Ministries and Groups

Adult Funeral Servers: Adults to assist at funeral liturgies. Training is provided.

Altar Guild: Members dedicate their time to the care of sanctuary and sacred vessels which are part of the liturgy. They gather regularly for cleaning bees and oversee the care of all that we use at liturgy.

Altar Servers: Boys and girls in grade 3 and above assist at Sunday liturgies. Training is provided

Baptism Bib Sewing: Cutting from a pattern, edging and cross stitching bibs

Catholic Women's League: A national organization of women dedicated to the church and country.

Charismatic Prayer Group: A gathering of parishioners who regularly pray in community.

Children's Playgroup: The children's playgroup gathers pre-schoolers and their caregivers each Tuesday morning. We are in need of those who can assist with planning and overseeing the activities.

Children's Worship: On Sunday morning children in JK through Grade 2 are invited to gather for the liturgy of word downstairs. We are in need of leaders who will assist on a monthly schedule.

Community Life: This group plans and brings to completion various social occasions for the whole parish and oversees coffee after Sunday mass.

Confirmation Leaders: Assisting and teaching the confirmation students as they prepare for the sacrament.

Counters: Men and women to assist with counting the collections. You will be on a monthly schedule and a police check is required.

Eucharistic Ministers: Assist with the distribution of communion, every few weeks.

Lectors: Readers at mass, every few weeks.

Knights of Columbus: A fraternity of men committed to the good of the church and the community.

Ministry to the Frail and Shut in: Taking communion and a friendly visit to those that are shut in.

Refugee Committee: Assisting with the integration of new comers to our country.

R.C.I.A.: Assisting those who wish to become members of the Catholic Church.

St. Vincent de Paul: Aiding those in our community who are living on limited resources.

Welcoming Arms: An ecumenical group that assists the poor of Aurora.

Welcome Table: An ecumenical group that provides a weekly meal for families in financial stress.

Youth Ministry: Volunteers ministering to the youth of our parish through the LifeTeen and EDGE Programs.
