We will be organizing a bible study for this spring when we have suitable meeting space available. The topic and start date will be announced next year.

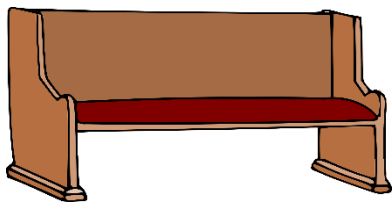
PET BLESSINGS - TODAY
