### HAVING A MASS SAID



It is thought as we move towards the month of November it is a good time to discuss having a mass said. This is a very old and venerable tradition in the church. Sometimes when people come to the office to do this they are a bit confused since there are two ways of having a mass said.

We can have an unannounced mass said. In that case one of the priests will say this mass when they are at a school or a nursing home. If the number of unannounced masses builds up we send them to the bishop's office and they are distributed among the retired priests to say.

An announced mass is said here at Our Lady of Grace on a specific day Monday to Saturday. First Saturday of the month we have multiple intentions because families often want a person remembered soon. If you were requesting a particular day at present at OLG it would have to be January or later.

If people want a mass for the anniversary of a death or on someone's birthday it is not inappropriate that you would come schedule that, now, for much later in the year.

The normal stipend for an unannounced mass is \$10.00 and for an announced mass is \$20.00. Nancy can give you a card to send to the family of the deceased if that seems helpful.

We, of course, continue the practice of praying for the recently departed at the five Sunday masses that follow the week of their death. Call Nancy to have names included.

### NOVEMBER THE MONTH OF HOLY SOULS

Once again, this year during November, the month of Holy Souls, we will include in our mass prayers those that you recommend to our prayers.

Envelopes will be available at the back of the church this weekend and the basket for envelopes will be by the Easter candle beginning on November 1.
