The capital campaign has been received well. We do not expect everyone to respond immediately, rather to do so when it is best for them.

We have had a significant amount of response to the 3,800 letters which have been sent out to all of our parish homes.

Parishioners have to date made pledges of \$343,410, this represents the commitment of 82 households. Thank you to those who have responded to date.

Our goal is to raise 3.1 million which these pledges when realized will reduce the goal to \$2,766,690. Thank you to everyone.
