BRING YOUR KIDS TO THE PARISH FOR CONFESSION

Over the years we have heard confessions in the elementary schools, but have now discontinued the practice. We have discontinued the practice because of the expense, we needed 8 to 10 priests, and the sense that trying to process the number of confessions involved was too much like an assembly line.

Instead this Lent we will send a package of preparation to each household through the elementary schools. This will include questions for discussion and an examination of conscience for adults who have been away from the sacrament for an extended period of time.

As with each sacrament we hope that centering preparation in the home will be a source of encouragement for families and offer more focused time to prepare at home.

We will print off a number of packages for families whose children are in private or public schools for pick up after mass.

We hope most of these families will come on April 10 at 7pm which is our scheduled evening for confessions. There will be a number of visiting priests here to assist with confessions.

LENTEN CONFESSIONS

Our evening for confessions with visiting priests will be on Wednesday April 10th at 7pm. We encourage as many as possible to select this time for confessions. There will be other times in Holy Week.

An examination for those who have been away from the sacrament for an extended period of time can be found at the entrances.
