HAS THE WINTER GOT YOU DOWN?

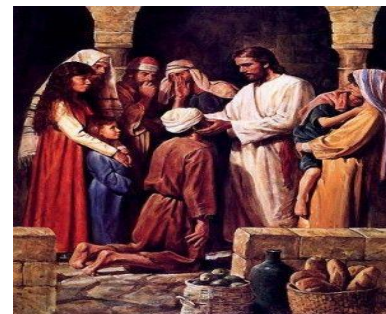
