Fr. Eduardo had knee surgery to repair a sports injury and is now in recovery. He is progressing well and will soon enough be back to normal.

Since mid-November Fr. Frank has been dealing with vertigo. (Vertigo is experiencing serious dizziness).

Because of the vertigo the week before Christmas he fell when locking up the church and has ended up with a mild concussion.

In the past his experience of vertigo would last three or four days, this is now coming up to three months. In addition to dizziness he is having balance issues when standing in one place for a period of time. That is the reason for sitting to preach and give communion.

The wisdom is that the vertigo and concussion will repair themselves. Both men are well served by doctors and ask for your prayers for a full recovery.
