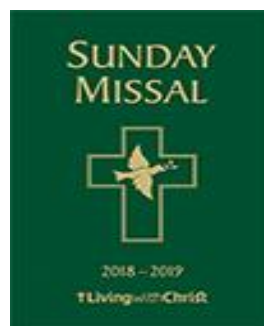
SAYING THANK YOU TO FR. MARIJAN

MISSALS

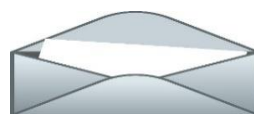


We have settled into Lynett Hall. Of course, there is no screen.
