Mass will be celebrated at 7pm this Friday, April 12<sup>th</sup> followed by the stations of the cross which will be led by members of the prayer group.

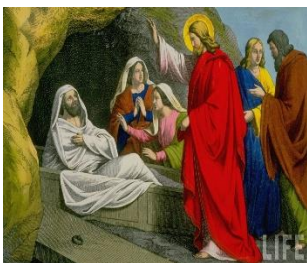
## FINANCIAL REPORT FOR 2018

Now that he has befriended its residents and staff, Ben will find the eventual transition less overwhelming. He has already developed a sense of belonging to his future community.
