OUR LADY OF GRACE CHILDREN'S PLAYGROUP CELEBRATES EASTER!



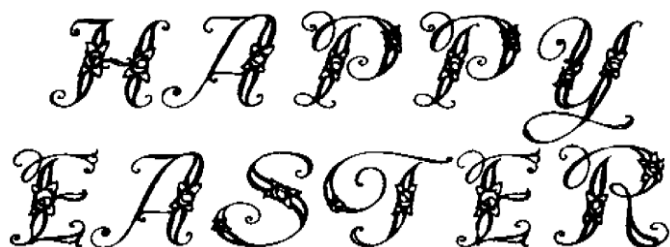
