WE ALL NEED TO WORK TOGETHER!

We have all been very fortunate to be able to attend mass over the past few months.

However, we wish to stress the importance of several points which will help keep us all safer during this pandemic.

WHERE ARE WE AT?

Slowly we are moving to the completion of this project here in our parish. Pews are pretty near complete. We are still waiting on the sanctuary furniture which was sent out for refinishing to return.

Landscaping will be undertaken throughout the fall. We anticipate our new outside sign within the month. There is still much to be done in the hall. We expect it will be done in a timely fashion.

The old house on Catherine St. is slowly coming together. The footings are in for the addition. The interior will be gutted and basic work done to prepare it for renovation. The renovation will not be done at this time. We will address ourselves to that in the future, but the exterior will be completed now. We will consider how to proceed on the house once we have a clear understanding of our financial situation at the end of this first phase.
