

WHEN CAN I RECEIVE COMMUNION IN HOLY WEEK EVEN THOUGH I AM NOT READY TO RETURN TO MASS?

On Holy Thursday from 8 to 8:30 p.m. we will give communion in the foyer of the church. (Prayer before the Blessed Sacrament will continue in the church during this time.) On Good Friday communion will be available in the church proper from 4:30 to 5:00 p.m. On Easter Sunday communion will be available from 11 to 11:30 a.m.

All of these opportunities for communion presume that you have watched on line the liturgy that proceeded it. All Sundays communion from 11-11:30am continues.

WHY VEIL STATUES?

Veiling statues is an ancient practice in the church. We draw back from the images for the solemn time of Lent and long for the coming of Easter when we can refocus on the sacred images. We are called to meditate more deeply on the words that tell us of salvation.

PALMS

As you can imagine palms are purchased in anticipation of Palm Sunday. Last year since we were locked down we could not distribute any palms that had been ordered at a cost of \$17.50 per bag. We have been cautious this year in ordering palms, finally settling on 500 as the rules changed. This year they will not be available before mass, rather they will be blessed during mass and distributed one per family after mass at the front of the church. This is done to try to respect the Covid regulations and to manage fairly what we have to distribute.

- Joining the CVITP (Community Volunteer Income Tax Program) where you would be trained and access the necessary tools to fulfil the role. A police check is also required to become a volunteer for our organizationcan be done remotely.
