EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE

Reconciliation is about claiming the freedom to be fully alive in our relationship with God and with others.

Do I cover my tracks with small lies and untruths? Do I give a full day's work to my employer and share responsibilities at home? If a student, do I see my studies as my first priority now? Do I avoid dishonesty, never taking what does not belong to me and being forthright in all of my dealings with others, including the government?

Am I greedy, too preoccupied with possessions and the bottom line to the detriment to being a good witness in faith? Do I take my position in the world and material well being too seriously?

Do I practice good stewardship? Do I waste food and other resources? Do I recognize the rights of the citizens of poor nations for food, water, and health?

Do I avoid behaviors that are harmful to me and to living an effective life? Do I avoid drinking to excess, the use of illicit drugs and gambling beyond my resources?

Do I set a standard of moral living for myself that is consistent with what I expect from others? Do I protect innocence and honor chastity? Do I avoid pornography on the internet and in other media? Do I see my sexuality as proof that God trusts me? Do I disappoint that trust?

Is my language appropriate at all times? Do I share joy, delight and hope? Do I have time to listen to others? Do I avoid gossip? Do I avoid narrow and prejudicial talk?

Act of Contrition O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended you, and I detest all my sins, because of Your just punishments, but most of all because they offend You, my God, who are all-good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of Your grace, to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin.
