MINISTRY IN OUR SCHOOLS

One of the great voids in our ministry as a parish is our absence from our schools. We are continuing to do what we can. We have recorded visits for the last three months of the year. April's discussion was on the Widow's mite, May is the two great commandments and June is the Ascension. The school is divided up more or less along divisions in the schools. Fr. Eduardo provides visits for Juniors, Sandra for Intermediates and Fr. Frank for Primaries.

We have also recorded two Easter masses one for elementary schools and one for secondary schools. Each school organizes this the best they can. We thank the schools for their cooperation with this outreach in this difficult time.

HOSPITAL VISITS

Priests are allowed into the hospital. There may be some situations, like Covid patients in ICU, where we would be limited in our ministry, but in general we are able to minister to the very seriously ill when we are on the pager. Access to nursing homes can be very limited, but in most parts of the hospital we are able to anoint.

LET'S TRY FIRST COME FIRST SERVE

Beginning next week you do not need to register for Mass. Over the course of the last year, we have been using Eventbrite to register for mass in an effort to keep our numbers within the provincial restrictions at any given time. This effort has not been without its challenges. Not all parishioners have computer access, and more often than not there are a couple of dozen registrations that do not show up for mass which prevents others from attending.

It will now be first come first serve. The church will be opened 15 minutes before Mass begins. If you come earlier you will need to wait outside. Please respect the social distancing directives and remember to wear your mask.

We are going to try our very best to seat people to get the most out of the space that we have. This worked very well over the Easter Triduum, so we will continue in this way. You will be asked to wait in the upper Narthex after you have signed in, and an usher will direct you to your seats.

Once we have reached capacity, we will be locking the doors and posting a sign indicating that we are full.

After Mass we ask that you do not linger as the space needs to be cleaned. We will continue to give Communion from 11-11:30AM to those who will be watching at home.


