ARE YOU NERVOUS ABOUT BEING AT MASS?

We have the hall set up with the screen to deal with overflow. It seems that there may be those who may make their way back to mass if they can have a clear distance from others. This is not to suggest that people have not been stellar in distancing themselves while in the church. The hall may provide that at the present time. We can make the hall available at the first 4 weekend masses for those who want that distance, and we will make it a point of always sending someone down with communion. We will not have the hall open at 7pm because the crowd does not justify it. This may not be possible in the long haul as crowds continue to increase. We are happy to observe the continued growth of the Sunday crowd at mass. It is also truly encouraging to see that we have had almost no need to speak to people about masks we truly appreciate your great cooperation.

COMMUNION AT 11:15 A.M.

We have over the past number of months offered communion to those watching mass online between 11 and 11:30 on Sunday morning. Those who attend have dwindled to a single digit group. We are going to change our practice and instead of being there for the half hour we will be there at 11:15 every Sunday for those who have gathered for communion. We, of course, look for the day when all of these efforts will become history.

CONGRATULATIONS TO FIRST COMMUNICANTS

This is the second weekend of First Communion masses. Congratulations to the children and their families on this important day in your child's life and in the life of the parish. All of these are children who have had to delay First Communion because of Covid. Thank you to their parents for their attentiveness bringing this day to reality.
