

BAPTISM AT OUR LADY OF GRACE

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord seems like a good time to review baptism here at Our Lady of Grace.

Families requesting baptism should be members of the parish. Those from outside the parish can come here for baptism after having done what is required in their own parish to prepare for baptism.

This idea of being a member of the parish causes some confusion. You are a member of the parish if you live in Aurora. There are also many who strictly speaking live beyond the boundaries of the parish but come to OLG weekly for mass. They are members of the parish by habit. You are not a member of the parish if you grew up here, went to school here and received your sacraments here, but have since married and have been living in Bolton for twelve years. Your parents may be members of the parish, if they still live here, but you are in fact a member of the Bolton parish.

To start the process of baptism, call the parish and we will arrange for a baptism package to be put out for you to pick up. When the package is completed then return it to the parish and we will have the parents in for a meeting. At that meeting we will usually set a date for baptism.

At present we are baptising with two families at a time. This works fairly well for distancing. The water is blessed in a jug and poured over the child's head from the jug. All other actions have been adjusted to avoid undue contact with the baby during the sacrament.
