WHAT IS THE PROCESS FOR AN ADULT BECOMING A CATHOLIC?

If an adult wishes to become a Catholic and has never been baptised, then we need to work towards baptism. We begin by inviting the interested party to come to mass. Once they have been exposed to the community at worship, we give them a book to read and then they meet to discuss with a member of the parish team. Ideally if numbers allow it, they will gather with others interested in becoming Catholic for some ongoing lessons. The process is of course groomed to each person's needs and abilities.

Often there are adults who are already baptised in a Protestant or Orthodox Church who wish to become Catholic. In these cases, the process is much the same, but may take less time if they have a good grounding in the Christian faith already.

In both cases the process begins by contacting the parish office.

WHAT DO I DO WITH MY ENVELOPES FROM 2021, 2020 OR 2019 THAT I NEVER USED?

Offering Envelopes

You could use them for shopping lists. They also

make excellent bookmarks. They make flash cards if you are working with your children on developing their vocabulary. If you have bored kids or grandkids around home, give them a box of crayons and the box with the remainder of last year's envelopes in it and tell them to create a game. You can string them together and put a letter on each one to make a 'Happy Birthday' sign or a sign for some other celebration. In fact, you can do almost anything you can imagine with your envelopes from 2021, 2020 or earlier. You can do anything but put money in them and put them on the collection plate. That little number on each envelope belongs to someone else for 2022 and they are getting credit for your donations. Just take a new box of envelopes from the back of the church and know that we are deeply appreciative of your commitment to support your parish.



THE PETITION BOX

This ministry specific to OLG has been an amazing success. The box is in the oratory with the

statues of Mary and Joseph during the week and in front of the altar on weekends. People are invited to put their written petitions in the box. They are remembered at each weekend mass. The box is emptied by the priests on a regular basis. It is important to note that the petitions are never read. They are very much an expression of your own prayer. It is such a positive expression of this most central expression of our Christian journey...... prayer.

SYNOD AND SYNODALITY

What is a Synod? A synod is a meeting to discuss an issue related to church life or practice. It may focus on the clarification of shared belief or quite simply be a coming together in the hope of creating consensus.

What is a Synod on Synodality? It is a bit of a mouthful, but it is quite simply coming together to discuss how the church hears, who it hears and how it responds. We are not just talking about the bishops but all members of the church.

Pope Francis is seeking to engage as many as possible in a process of discussion and reflection on how we move forward as a church. Who does he want to hear from? In these initial stages he wants to hear from you, but not just you. He wants to hear from Catholics who have distanced themselves from the church. He wants to hear from Christians from the Protestant and Orthodox traditions. He wants to hear from non-believers. He wishes to hear from all since the church is in the world and needs to be in dialogue with all who are in the world with us.

It is a recognition that the church may historically have been deaf in some situations, and this of course injures the ministry of the church. It would be hard at this point to find someone who does not recognize that we have been deaf in many ways in relationship with the indigenous people of our country.

How can you be involved at this point? Please complete the questionnaire which is found on the parish website under the Synod on Synodality. If you do not have easy access to the website or a computer there are hard copies of the questionnaire on the bench near the office. Take them home complete them and put them in the box on the bench by the office.
