FOOT WASHING ON HOLY THURSDAY

After the homily on Holy Thursday, we will do the rite of foot washing. All will be invited to come forward to participate in the rite. If you are coming forward, you take a seat and remove the shoe and the sock from one of your feet.

ADORATION ON HOLY THURSDAY

We will leave the church open till 11 p.m. for those who wish to spend some time with the Lord. In remembrance of this night of the arrest of Jesus the Blessed Sacrament is relocated in the church. It will after mass till 11 be in the oratory where the statue of Mary and Joseph are. People are invited to come and go as they wish.

GOOD FRIDAY

The Good Friday service concludes with veneration of the cross. Tradition is that people come forward to kiss the cross or at least touch it. This year in awareness of Covid we will venerate the cross by bowing to it. You may wish to come forward in procession and do this or you may do it from your pew before you leave church.

THE COLLECTION FOR THE HOLY LAND

The Collection for the Holy Land is taken up on Good Friday. Envelopes are available at the back for pick up. Just put them in the baskets on your way into church for Good Friday. These funds are used to care for the holy sites in Israel.

BLESSING FOOD AT 12 NOON SATURDAY

Blessing food is very much part of the tradition of people from eastern Europe. The food which focuses on the Easter message is used to break their fast and begin the celebrations of Easter. Although it is the tradition of those from Europe, there is nothing to stop it from becoming part of your families' traditions.

CLARIFICATIONS ON EASTER VIGIL

People often stay away from the Vigil on Saturday evening at 8 because they have the perception that it will be hours long. Actually, in our parish it will be a bit longer than Sunday mass. People also have had the impression that it does not fulfill our duty to go to mass that weekend. Those coming Saturday night are not required to come on Sunday morning. The third confusion is that there is no collection at the vigil. Of course, there is a collection at the vigil for those who wish to participate.
