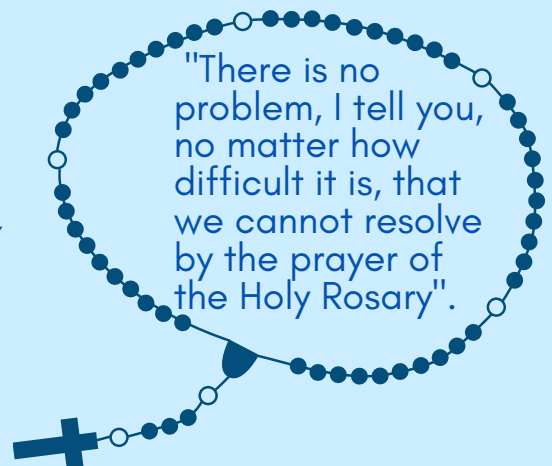

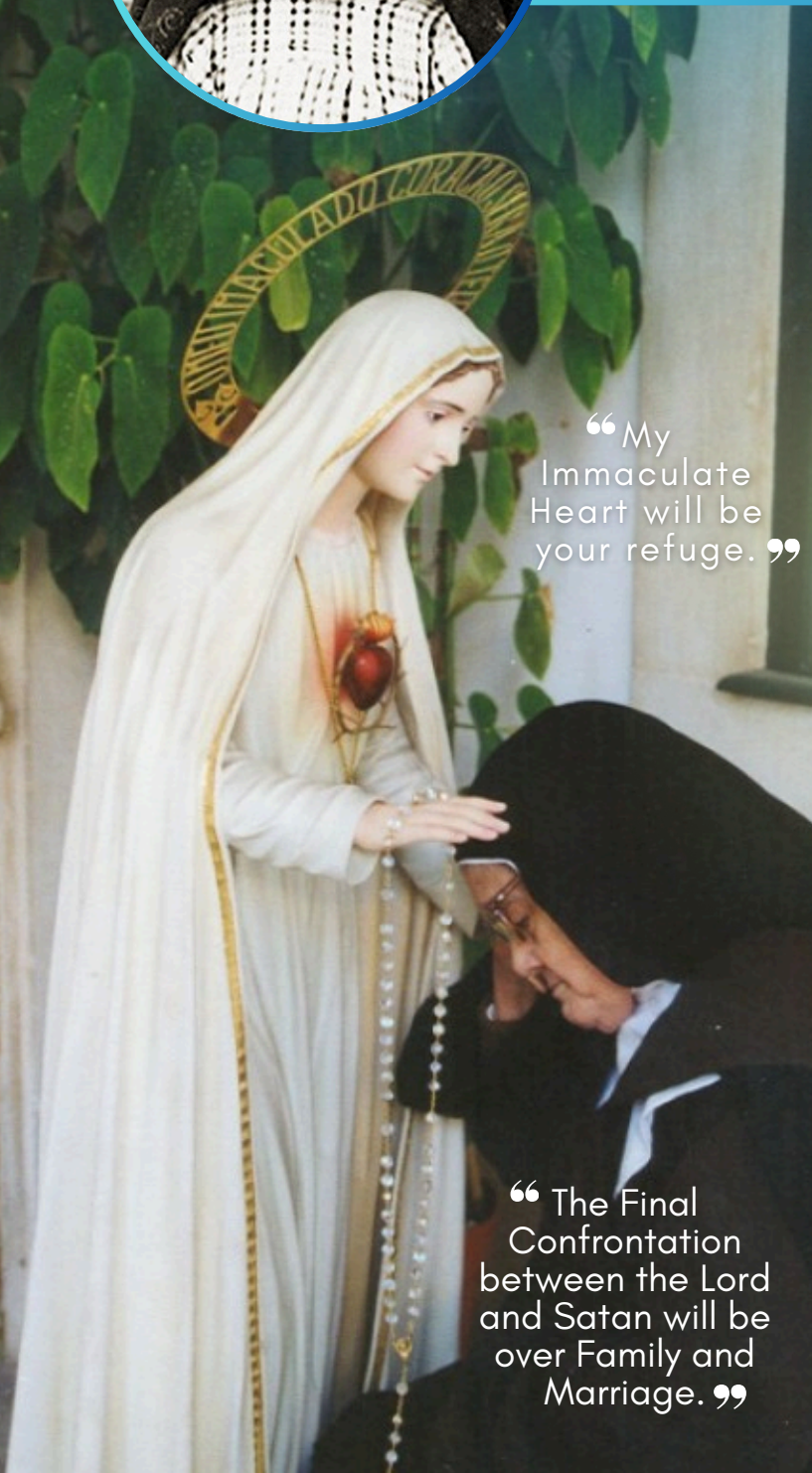
Sister Lúcia of Fatima endured significant suffering after the Our Lady of Fátima apparitions. She was interrogated and threatened by authorities, lost her cousins Francisco Marto and Jacinta Marto (now Saints), and lived much of her life in religious seclusion in a Carmelite convent in Coimbra. She also carried the heavy responsibility of safeguarding the “Three Secrets of Fátima.”
